

ORDINANCE NO. 884

AN ORDINANCE amending rates for sewer service.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF OROVILLE, WASHINGTON, DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Subsection (a) of Section 13.08.020 of the Oroville Municipal Code, which reads as follows:

13.08.020 - Rates and Charges - Designated.

(a) The monthly rates and charges for sewage treatment and disposal service for buildings with separate water meters for each business shall be as follows:

<u>Inside City Limits:</u>	
Residential	\$28.00 per dwelling (includes all duplexes, triplexes and mobile/ manufactured homes, including in mobile home parks and condominiums with separate ownership)
Apartments and multi-family residential	\$28.00 first unit plus \$17.50 per additional unit (the owner or a designated unit shall pay the first unit base)
Commercial rates	\$29.50 plus \$.95 per 1,000 gallons in excess of 10,000 gallons; \$18.50 per additional commercial unit
<u>Outside City Limits:</u>	
Residential	\$41.50 per dwelling (includes all duplexes, triplexes and mobile/ manufactured homes, including in mobile home parks and condominiums with separate ownership)
Apartments and multi-family residential	\$41.50 first unit plus \$19.00 per additional unit (the owner or a designated unit shall pay the first unit base)
Commercial rates	\$42.50 plus \$.95 per 1,000 gallons in excess of 10,000 gallons; \$20.50 per additional commercial unit

<u>Service</u>	<u>Rates Effective 01/01/2016</u>
<u>Inside City Limits:</u>	
Residential	\$30.00 per dwelling (includes all duplexes, triplexes and mobile/ manufactured homes, including in mobile home parks and condominiums with separate ownership)
Apartments and multi-family residential	\$30.00 first unit plus \$17.50 per additional unit (the owner or a designated unit shall pay the first unit base)
Commercial rates	\$31.50 plus \$.95 per 1,000 gallons in excess of 10,000 gallons; \$18.50 per additional commercial unit
<u>Outside City Limits:</u>	
Residential	\$43.50 per dwelling (includes all duplexes, triplexes and mobile/ manufactured homes, including in mobile home parks and condominiums with separate ownership)
Apartments and multi-family residential	\$43.50 first unit plus \$19.00 per additional unit (the owner or a designated unit shall pay the first unit base)
Commercial rates	\$44.50 plus \$.95 per 1,000 gallons in excess of 10,000 gallons; \$20.50 per additional commercial unit

<u>Service</u>	<u>Rates Effective 01/01/2017</u>
<u>Inside City Limits:</u>	
Residential	\$32.00 per dwelling (includes all duplexes, triplexes and mobile/ manufactured homes, including in mobile home parks and condominiums with separate ownership)

Apartments and multi-family residential \$32.00 first unit plus \$17.50 per additional unit (the owner or a designated unit shall pay the first unit base)

Commercial rates \$33.50 plus \$.95 per 1,000 gallons in excess of 10,000 gallons; \$18.50 per additional commercial unit

Outside City Limits:

Residential \$45.50 per dwelling (includes all duplexes, triplexes and mobile/ manufactured homes, including in mobile home parks and condominiums with separate ownership)

Apartments and multi-family residential \$45.50 first unit plus \$19.00 per additional unit (the owner or a designated unit shall pay the first unit base)

Commercial rates \$46.50 plus \$.95 per 1,000 gallons in excess of 10,000 gallons; \$20.50 per additional commercial unit

is hereby amended to read as follows:

Service Rates Effective 01/01/2020

Inside City Limits:

Residential \$34.00 per dwelling (includes all duplexes, triplexes and mobile/ manufactured homes, including in mobile home parks and condominiums with separate ownership)

Apartments and multi-family residential \$34.00 first unit plus \$18.50 per additional unit (the owner or a designated unit shall pay the first unit base)

Commercial rates \$35.50 plus \$.95 per 1,000 gallons in excess of 10,000 gallons; \$19.50 per additional commercial unit

Outside City Limits:

Residential \$47.50 per dwelling (includes all duplexes, triplexes and mobile/ manufactured homes, including in mobile home parks and condominiums with separate ownership)


Apartments and multi-family residential \$47.50 first unit plus \$20.00 per additional unit (the owner or a designated unit shall pay the first unit base)

Commercial rates \$48.50 plus \$.95 per 1,000 gallons in excess of 10,000 gallons; \$21.50 per additional commercial unit

Section 2. This ordinance shall become effective from and after its passage by the council, approval by the Mayor and five days after publication of this ordinance, or a summary, as provided by law, or January 1, 2020, whichever is later.
